


LOOK WHO'S TALKING

1 Follow the way of love and eagerly desire gifts of the Spirit, especially prophecy.




Prophecy is not "Foretelling" but rather "forth-telling" the mind and heart of God



Prophetic supernaturally hearing from God what you could not know by natural means




What is the purpose of prophecy?

Purpose of Prophecy


- Strengthen (Edify) literally means the act of building

 (intimately) with tenderness





I Timothy 4: 14

Acts 13: 1

1 Now in the church at Antioch there were prophets and teachers: Barnabas, Simeon called Niger, Lucius of Cyrene, Manaen (who had been brought up with Herod the tetrarch) and Saul.



Acts 13: 2 - 3

2 While they were worshiping the Lord and fasting, the Holy Spirit said, "Set apart for me Barnabas and Saul for the work to which I have called them." 3 So after they had fasted and prayed, they placed their hands on them and sent them off.



Acts 10: 10 - 13

10 He became hungry and wanted something to eat, and while the meal was being prepared, he fell into a trance. 11 He saw heaven opened and something like a large sheet being let down to earth by its four corners. 12 It contained all kinds of four-



footed animals, as well as reptiles and birds. 13 Then a voice told him, "Get up, Peter. Kill and eat."

Acts 16: 6 - 8

6 Paul and his companions traveled throughout the region of Phrygia and Galatia, having been kept by the Holy Spirit from preaching the word in the province of Asia. 7 When they came to the border of Mysia, they tried to enter Bithynia, but the Spirit of Jesus



would not allow them to. 8 So they passed by Mysia and went down to Troas.

Acts 16: 9 - 10

9 During the night Paul had a vision of a man of Macedonia standing and begging him, "Come over to Macedonia and help us." 10 After Paul had seen the vision, we got ready at once to leave for Macedonia, concluding that God had called us to preach the gospel to them.
